THE USE OF THE <u>AUXILARY VERB **DID**</u> IN THE PAST TENSE

- -The **Auxiliary Verb Did** is going to help us to make negative and interrogative sentences in the past tense
- -We use auxiliary verb DID with regular and irregular verbs
- -Except with the verb To be
- -Example: WITH VERB TO BE
- Aff. I<u>was</u>thirsty yesterday.
- Neg. I <u>wasn'</u>thirsty yesterday.
- Int. <u>Was I thirsty yesterday?</u>
- ASA: yes you were NSA. No you weren't
 - -Example with other verb.
- Aff. I<u>drank</u> water yesterday morning.
- Neg. I din't <u>drink</u> water yesterday morning.
- Int. Did I <u>drink</u> water every morning?
- ASA. Yes you did NSA. No you didn't



Auxiliary verbs Do, Does, and Did

Present Tense

Use <u>Do</u> and <u>Doe</u>s (third person)

Example: (use the present of the verbs)

Aff. You **go** to School every day.

Neg. You don't go to School every day.

Int. Do you go to School every day?

ASA. Yes I do NSA. No. I don't

(Add S or Es on third person)

Aff. She **plays** soccer every week.

Neg. She doesn't <u>play</u> soccer every day.

Neg. Does She <u>play</u> soccer every day?

ASA. Yes she does NSA. No she doesn't

Past Tense

Use **Did** for all the Pronouns

Example: (use the past in the aff. form)

Aff. You went to church last Sunday

Neg. You didn't go to church last Sunday

Int. Did you go to church last Sunday?

ASA. Yes I did NSA. No I didn't

Aff. She played soccer last week.

Neg. Se didn't <u>play</u> soccer last week.

Int. Did she <u>play</u> soccer last week?

ASA. Yes she did NSA. No. She didn't
